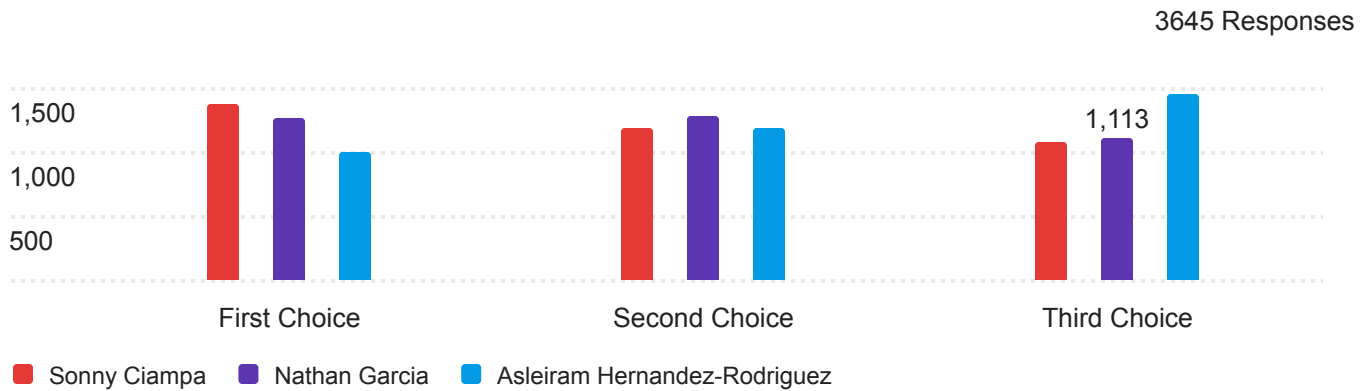


# 2026 ASI General Election Results

A total of 3702 votes were cast at 9.24% of the eligible-to-vote student population in the 2026 ASI Elections. Voters were able to abstain from voting for specific positions, providing explanation as to why response rates may be lower than total ballot submissions.

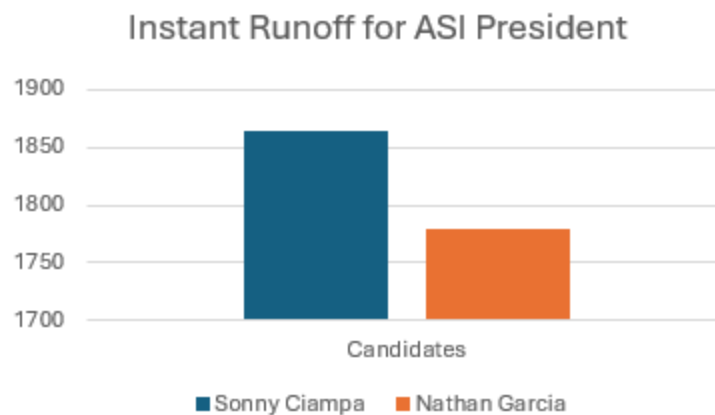

### Recalculated Totals:

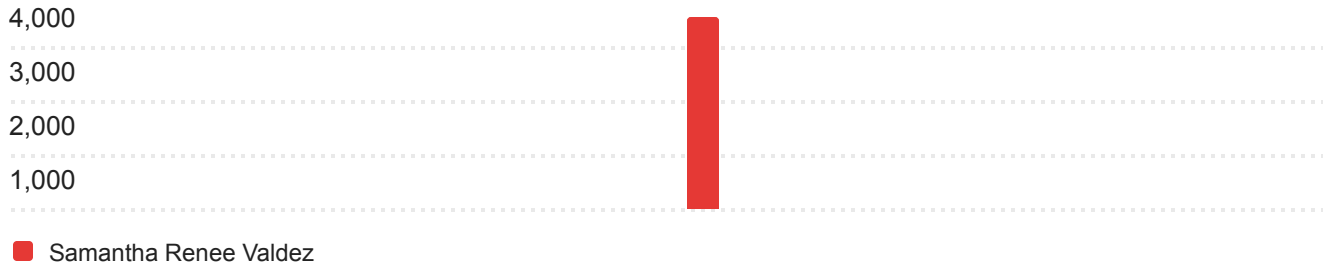
- Sonny Ciampa receives 1,865 (51%) votes

  - This is calculated by Nathan's original 1,258 votes plus the redistributed 522 votes.

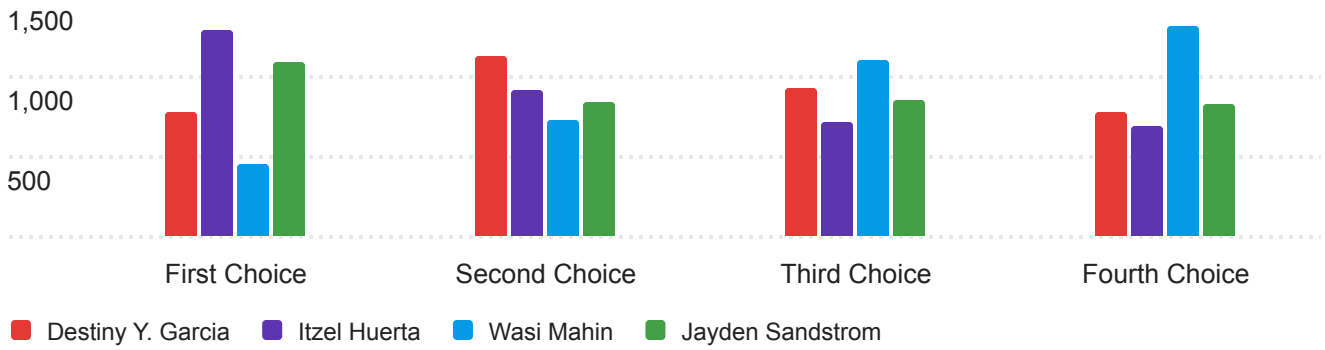

### Recalculated Totals:

- Destiny Y. Garica receives 905 (25%) votes
  - This is calculated by Destiny's original 770 votes plus the redistributed 135 votes.
- Itzel Huerta receives 1,430 (40%) votes.
  - This is calculated by Itzel's original 1,284 votes plus the redistributed 146 votes.
- Jayden Sandstrom receives 1,255 (35%) votes.
  - This is calculated by Jayden's original 1,084 votes plus the redistributed 171 votes.

**No candidate with over 50% of votes. Second round of run-off needed.**

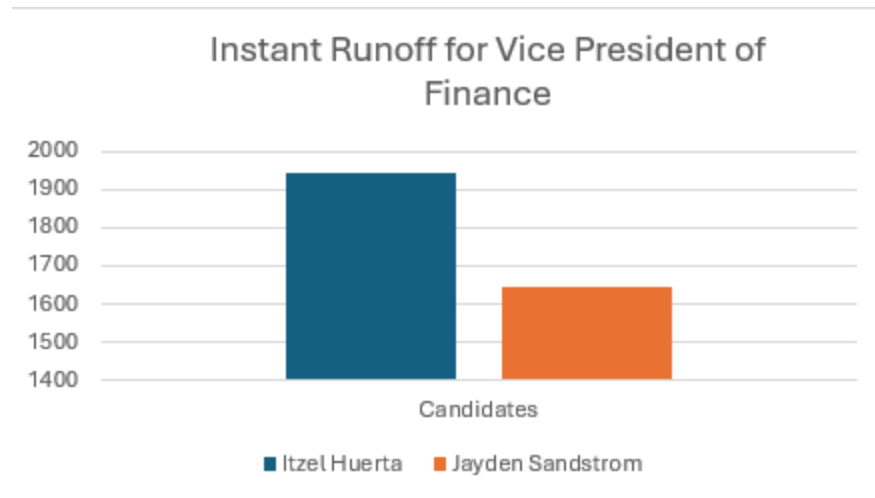

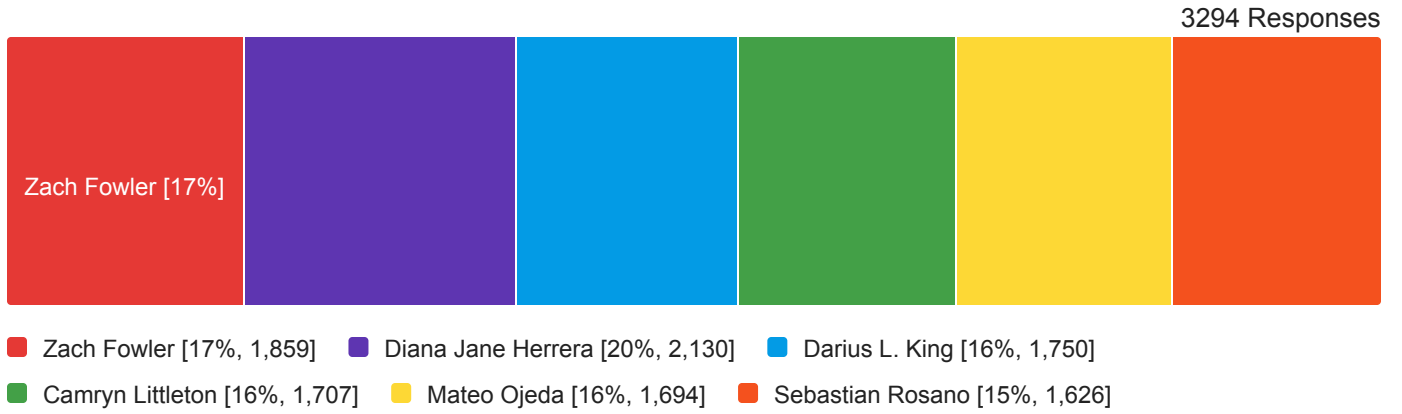
## Recalculated Totals:

- Itzel Huerta receives 1,945 (54%) votes.
  - This is calculated by the results from the first instant run-off votes (1,430) plus redistributed votes from the second instant run-off round (515).
- Jayden Sandstrom receives 1,645 (46%) votes.
  - This is calculated by the results from the first instant run-off votes (1,255) plus redistributed votes from the second instant run-off round (390).

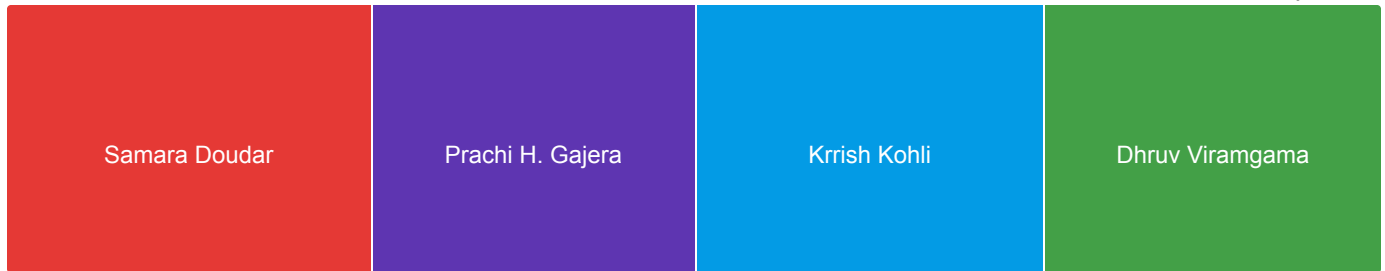

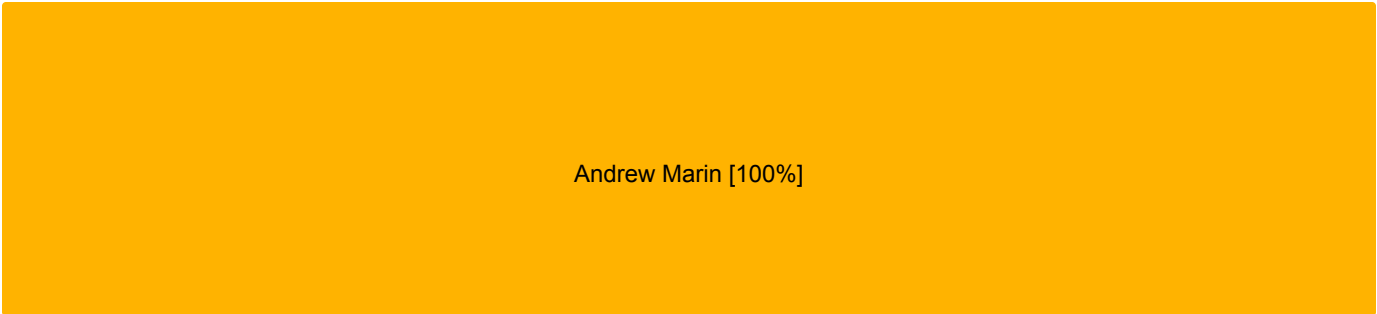
